



Cataracts are a significant issue in Pakistan, causing vision impairment or blindness for many individuals, especially those from lower-income backgrounds who cannot afford treatment.

To address this, the Muazzam Foundation held its 7th Annual FREE Eye Camp on 2nd and 3rd December 2023 at Muazzam Hospital in Jhelum.



Supported by a team of expert eye specialists from Al-Shifa Eye Trust Hospital, Rawalpindi, the camp restored sight and independence to many, alleviating a critical need for the community.

For the upcoming year, the goal is to conduct an additional 200+ cataract operations, further expanding the reach and effectiveness of this vital service.



Before the surgery, I struggled to see even the faces of my loved ones. The cloudiness in my vision made everyday tasks difficult and frustrating. Thanks to the free eye camp organised by the Muazzam Foundation, I can now see clearly again. At Captain Muazzam Ali Shaheed Welfare Hospital, we are committed to ensuring patients receive the treatment they need, even if it means referring them to external hospitals and covering the associated costs.

2023-24 Impact

2 cancer patients supported with comprehensive care, including:

- Chemotherapy
- Routine check-ups
- Medications

Patient Treatment Costs:

- Patient 1: Rs 3,002,394
- Patient 2: Rs 1,530,080

One of the patients, a 40-year-old and the sole provider for his family, was battling severe health conditions. Despite receiving treatment, he sadly passed away in January 2024. In response to this tragedy, the Foundation now provides financial assistance to his family:

• Monthly Stipend: Rs 38,000 for his wife and three children

This support offers much-needed stability during an incredibly difficult time, reaffirming our commitment to standing by those in need.



Water Projects

Total Donated Funds: £13,431.91

Hand Pumps & Solar: £5,087

Access to clean water is a fundamental human right, yet many communities in Pakistan face severe water scarcity and sanitation challenges. Contaminated water sources in Sindh lead to widespread illnesses like cholera, dysentery, and hepatitis, disproportionately affecting children and the elderly. Poor sanitation also exacerbates malnutrition and food safety issues.

The Muazzam Foundation is addressing these challenges with sustainable solutions to improve access to clean water and sanitation facilities.

These efforts not only meet immediate water needs but also build a foundation for better health, economic growth, and well-being in vulnerable communities. With your support, we have significantly reduced waterborne diseases, improved public health, and enhanced food safety and hygiene standards.





Installed for sustainable energy, powering water pumps and purification systems, reducing reliance on grid and diesel power



66 Handpumps: Serving residential and commercial needs, enhancing water access in areas without conventional water supply infrastructure.

Water Coolers and Filtration Plants: Set up in Mardan and Sindh, providing communities with clean, safe drinking water







2 Water Tankers Daily: Delivering 1,000 litres each to over 1,000 families in Parachinar, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK).



Households Reached: 200+ households across 2 villages benefit from reliable, safe water delivery.

Daily Water Tankers in Parachinar: £7,598



In Parachinar, a remote mountainous region in Pakistan, residents face a profound struggle to access clean water, hindered by their isolation and the lack of basic infrastructure. Many families are forced to trek nearly a mile on foot and with donkeys to reach the nearest water source, which is often contaminated and insufficient for their needs.

Food Projects

Total Donated Funds: £2,731.04

Food is not only a necessity but also a source of comfort and healing. Through its **Food Projects**, the Muazzam Foundation addresses the nutritional needs of vulnerable communities, ensuring that those in need receive sustenance and support.

Hot Meals for Hospital Patients

Captain Muazzam Ali Shaheed Welfare Trust Hospital in Jhelum

- Funds Allocated: £1,482,57
- Daily Hot Meals for 30 patients
- Rs 400,000 Annually to ensure quality meals

The provision of healthy, hygienic meals not only supports patients' physical recovery but also enhances their overall comfort during hospital stays.







Qurbani

Food insecurity remains a significant challenge in Pakistan and India, leaving many families with limited access to nutritious meals. During Eid-ul-Adha, the Muazzam Foundation carried out Qurbani on behalf of donors.

Following this, Muazzam Foundation undertook the crucial task of distributing the meat among the most deprived and deserving families across India and Pakistan. Our distribution efforts were focused on reaching communities where access to nutritious food is limited, thereby addressing a critical gap in their diets.



- Beneficiaries: Over 12,000 individuals
- Funds Allocated: £1,248.47
- Animal Shares:
 - 35 shares in large animals
 - 3 small animals

The Qurbani was conducted under strict Islamic guidelines, ensuring the meat was of the highest quality. This initiative brought not just physical nourishment but also spiritual blessings to families who might otherwise go without.

Ramadan 2024 Total Donated Funds: £38,159.41 Eid Gifts

The Muazzam Foundation has truly embraced the spirit of Eid by bringing joy and celebration to many children. During Eid-ul-Fitr and Eid-ul-Adha, the Foundation made sure over 700 children experienced the festive cheer through thoughtful gifts and events.

Each child received a carefully chosen gift, reflecting the diverse needs and preferences of the recipients. The celebration also included a magic show and refreshments like juices and bakery items, adding to the festive atmosphere.

Fidya and Fitrana Distribution


During Ramadan 2024, the Muazzam Foundation channelled the spirit of giving to support those in need.



Through Fidya, we provided essential food packs to underprivileged families, ensuring they had access to nutritious meals during the holy month.



Fitrana, a vital component of Zakat al-Fitr, was distributed in cash to the poor, orphans, students, and families, allowing them to address immediate needs and partake in Eid celebrations with dignity and joy.



Food Packs

In the sacred month of Ramadan 2024, the Muazzam Foundation made a significant impact by addressing food insecurity in underserved communities. Rooted in the principles of compassion and giving, our efforts provided critical support to families struggling to meet their basic needs during this blessed time.

We distributed over 2,100 food packs, each carefully assembled with essential staples like flour, sugar, lentils, chickpeas, vermicelli, and oil. These items were selected to ensure that families had access to nutritious food for the entire month, enabling them to focus on their spiritual and personal well-being.

Hot Iftar Total Spent: £1,093.02

Hot iftaar meals were distributed daily at Jamia Masjid Raza and Muazzam Hospital, benefiting fasting individuals, including hospital staff, patients, and attendants. The meals included hot dishes and refreshing drinks, ensuring wholesome nourishment for hundreds daily.



Housing Project

The devastating floods of 2022 caused widespread destruction across Pakistan, particularly in Sindh and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK). Thousands of families were left homeless, with severely damaged infrastructure and heightened poverty levels. In response, the Muazzam Foundation launched its Housing Project to provide relief and rebuild lives in some of the most severely impacted regions.



These homes provide more than just shelter—they restore dignity and security, allowing families to focus on rebuilding their lives rather than struggling with inadequate living conditions.



The Muazzam Foundation's Housing Project has been a lifeline for flood-affected families, with the construction of 11 homes marking a meaningful step towards recovery. Continued support is crucial to extend this impact, helping more families rebuild their lives and achieve long-term stability.



Masjid Projects

Total Donated Funds: <u>£101,322.41</u>



In Islam, a masjid is more than a place of worship—it is a cornerstone of spiritual, educational, and social life within the community. Unfortunately, many communities in Pakistan lack access to functional masjids, with some forced to use damaged or neglected facilities. This limits their ability to worship, learn, and participate in communal activities, highlighting the urgent need for improved religious infrastructure.

The Muazzam Foundation is committed to addressing this challenge by building new masjids and restoring neglected ones. In 2023-24, the Foundation constructed six new masjids and renovated multiple others, providing critical support to underserved and remote communities.



Madrassah Maryam (Sindh)



- Opened in May 2024
- 2. Accommodates 50-60 boys and girls

Masjid Furqan (Nawab Shah, Sindh)



- 1. Supported by a £50,000 donation and 1 acre of land gifted by a local donor
- 2. Accommodates 250 worshippers and 100 students
- 3. Plans include expanding to a madrassah for **1,000 students**, offering hifz and secular education

Masjid Sakina Begum (Kohi Ratta, Azad Kashmir)



- 1. Completed with £12,000 funding
- 2. Accommodates 150 worshippers

Masjid Razia Begum (Kohistan, KPK)



- 1. Under construction with a £5,500 budget
- 2. Expected completion by August-September 2024.
- 3. Will serve 100 worshippers
- 4. Space for 50-80 students to learn the Quran

Masjid Raza (Jhelum)



- 1. Completed with £1,000 funding in August 2023.
- 2. Serves **100 worshippers** and students
- Offering free Islamic education

Widow & Family Care Wedding Support

G Gah's Messenger (peace be upon him) said, "When a man marries, he has fulfilled half of the 'deen' (religion); so let him fear Allah regarding the remaining half." At-Tirmidhi

Amid the ongoing financial crisis in Pakistan, many families face immense challenges in arranging marriages due to poverty. The Muazzam Foundation has stepped in to provide meaningful support, ensuring that deserving daughters can marry with dignity and respect.

Wedding Support: £7636.40

35 orphan girls celebrated in a combined ceremony.

36 widows supported withindividual wedding ceremonies. Financial aid of Rs 70,000-120,000 per wedding, covering:

Essential household items (e.g., double bed, cupboard/dressing table, or sofa set). Food costs for 100 guests at each wedding reception (Barat).



Widowhood is a deeply challenging experience, particularly in Pakistan, where government support is minimal, and many are left to manage household responsibilities alone. Recognising their vulnerability, the Muazzam Foundation provides financial assistance covering essential needs, including rent, household expenses, medical care, and education for their children.

Recognising this, the Muazzam Foundation, through the **Fareeda Bashir Trust**, is dedicated to transforming the lives of orphans by meeting their essential needs and nurturing their growth.





In partnership with the Fareeda Bashir Trust, the Muazzam Foundation sponsored the care and education of **15 orphans,** providing:



Educational Support: School fees, textbooks, and stationery to ensure access to quality education.



Healthcare: Regular medical check-ups and necessary treatments for overall well-being.



Daily Needs: Clothing, toiletries, and other essentials for a secure and comfortable life.

The Muazzam Foundation's **Empowering Communities** initiative is dedicated to addressing socio-economic challenges and creating sustainable opportunities for vulnerable individuals and families. In 2023-24, through innovative projects and community-driven solutions, the Foundation has transformed lives, fostering dignity, independence, and hope.

Rozgaar Mela (Job Fair)

Funds Allocated: £22,000

In response to the dire financial situation in Pakistan, Muazzam Foundation organised a landmark job fair in December 2023, marking the largest event of its kind in Jhelum. This initiative aimed to provide crucial support and employment opportunities to vulnerable communities, including youth, men, women and widows with limited access to income-generating resources.

The job fair profoundly transformed lives and benefitted the entire community. The ability to earn a halal income through dignified work is not only important for financial stability but also for maintaining personal integrity and self-respect.



123 Sewing Machines: Distributed to women and widows, enabling home-based businesses and financial independence.



30 Laptops: Awarded to students from Fareeda Bashir Trust and Saya Homes, improving education and digital literacy





90+ Food Carts: Launched small businesses, empowering unemployed individuals to earn sustainable incomes.

15heelchairs: Provided to disabled individuals, enhancing their mobility and independence.

Education



Financial Support: £9180

Education is a cornerstone of personal and societal development, yet countless children in Pakistan are denied this opportunity due to poverty and cultural barriers. Economic struggles often force families to prioritise basic needs over education, with costs for uniforms, textbooks, and transportation proving unaffordable.

Recognising the transformative power of education, the Muazzam Foundation has committed to addressing these challenges by providing targeted financial and resource support.

Financial Support Funds Allocated: £9180



Primary Education: Monthly fees of **Rs 1,200** covered for three students at Pak Serhan School in Kala Gujran, Jhelum



Higher Education: Scholarships awarded to 12 degree-level students



Rs 54,100 per month allocated to support **15 students** at Madrassa Zia Ul Aloom in Attock



Al-Qasim Institute (Special Needs Education)

Funds Allocated: £1,562.91

The Al-Qasim Institute in Jhelum is a beacon of hope for students with special needs, offering a tailored and supportive environment for their growth and development.



13 Sponsored Students: Comprehensive care included education, uniforms, and specialised therapies such as physical, occupational, and speech therapy to meet their unique needs.



Teacher Salaries: 5% of monthly salaries (Rs 11,560) Customized programs tailored to each student's needs for an effective learning experience.



Global Recognition: In June 2023, students represented Pakistan at the Special Olympics Games in Berlin, winning gold, silver, and bronze medals, a proud moment showcasing their resilience and potential.

This initiative highlights the importance of inclusive education, enabling children with special needs to thrive both locally and globally.



AL-Zohra Sadiq Vocational Institute

The Al-Zohra Sadiq Vocational Institute in Jhelum is dedicated to empowering women and widows by providing free vocational training. By equipping them with essential skills, the institute helps these women achieve financial independence, self-reliance, and a brighter future. Many graduates become primary earners in their households, contributing halal income and transforming their families' lives.

60+ Students Trained: Women and widows completed courses in:

- Sewing, knitting, cutting and designing
- Jewellery making
- Cooking
- Computer skills

60-80 graduates recieved tools and support to launch their own businesses, including:

- Sewing machines
- Jewellery-making tools
- Laptops
- Financial aid



Qur'an & Islamic Book Distribution

Funds Allocated: £689

In the year 2023-24, a significant effort was made to promote Islamic education and understanding by distributing Qurans and Islamic books in various educational institutions. Alhamdulillah, we distributed over 250 Qurans and Islamic educational books in Jamiya Ayesha Sadiqa & Madrasa in Bilal Town, Jhelum.

The Qur'ans and books enriched the curriculum, offering students and staff valuable resources to deepen their understanding of Islamic principles, history, and teachings.



Uniform Distribution Funds Allocated: £2,000

The financial burden of school uniforms often deters families from sending children to school. To address this, the Foundation distributed over 780 uniforms to students in underserved communities, including:

- Govt Boys & Girls High School, Jhelum
- Govt Boys & Girls High School, Kashmir Colony
- Govt High School, Garmala, Jhelum

By alleviating this expense, the Foundation helped more children attend school with dignity, focus, and a renewed sense of purpose.



Multi Skill Hub Centre



In Pakistan, widespread poverty and a challenging financial climate have made it difficult for many individuals to access quality education and vocational training, leaving them without the skills needed for stable employment. Recognising this critical gap, the Muazzam Foundation established the Multi Skill Hub Centre on August 14, 2023, to empower communities through practical skill development.

The centre offers a diverse range of courses to enhance their livelihood opportunities:






Digital Skills: Amazon Virtual Assistant, Graphic Design, Digital Marketing, Freelancing, Videography & Video Editing Jhelum.

Technical Skills: Mobile Repairing, Electrician, Electronics Technician







Welfare Training: Welfare Academy





A key feature of the Multi Skill Hub Centre is its commitment to affordability. Courses are offered at significantly lower fees compared to other institutions. The **Welfare Academy**, a vital part of the centre, operates on a welfare model, charging only **Rs 500 for all subjects**, allowing even the most financially disadvantaged students to benefit from its programs.

Over 500 students trained in various disciplines.

More than 600 graduates equipped with multi-skills.

Rs 1,500,000 in subsidies provided to reduce costs for students.

Annual Teacher Salaries: Rs 11,12,000, ensuring high-quality instruction.





IT Centre Funds Allocated: £4,000

The IT Centre, supported by the **As-Salaam Foundation**, is a cutting-edge facility equipped with modern computers, projectors, and LCDs, providing state-of-the-art IT training. This initiative not only enhances employment prospects for students but also contributes to their overall economic well-being, reflecting the centre's commitment to fostering skill development and community growth.

Masiid Sakina Begu

Fazal Mola's Story

Fazal Mola, once struggling with financial hardship, has regained stability through the Muazzam Foundation's support. By providing him with a fully equipped cart stocked with shoes and chappals, the Foundation enabled Fazal to return to his trade, earning a dignified halal income to sustain his family. With ongoing guidance, Fazal now has the potential to grow his business, ensuring long-term financial independence and a better quality of life.

Masjid Sakina Begum, Kohi Ratta

The construction of Masjid Sakina Begum in Kohi Ratta, Azad Kashmir, has transformed the lives of over 300 households by providing a dedicated space for worship and community gatherings. This initiative has strengthened spiritual and social bonds in the area, addressing a critical gap in communal facilities and underscoring the Muazzam Foundation's commitment to supporting religious and social needs.

Solar-Powered Water Plant, Dodo Rajar

The installation of a solar-powered water plant in Dodo Rajar, Sindh, has brought clean, reliable water to a community that once walked miles daily for this basic need. This project has drastically improved health, education, and livelihoods by reducing waterborne diseases and freeing women and children to focus on other pursuits. Ongoing maintenance and training ensure the long-term sustainability of this life-changing initiative.



FUNDRAISING

The majority of our funding comes from generous monthly donations, with a **significant portion collected during Ramadan through masjid collections**.

This blessed month is a time when giving charity, including Zakat, Sadaqah, Lillah, and Fitrana, is highly encouraged, allowing us to gather crucial resources to sustain and expand our projects. These contributions play a pivotal role in delivering essential services such as clean water, healthcare, education, and vocational training to underprivileged communities in Pakistan.

Ramadan donations enable us to implement the majority of our initiatives, ensuring impactful and timely support for those in need, while fostering a shared mission of compassion and empowerment





Last year, we hosted a **Tough Mudder event**, uniting participants to tackle a challenging obstacle course. The event raised £8,600, significantly supporting our efforts to transform lives. Additionally, our global campaigns on LaunchGood raised \$6,559.97, helping us connect with supporters worldwide.


